Punctuality—New Year, New Start!

Please ensure you bring your children into the school building if

they are late. Adults will close the doors at 9am prompt as they will be needed to support learning in school. It is your responsibility to ensure that children get into the school building. There will not always be a member of staff in the office to unlock the gate and you may have to wait with your child.

A polite reminder that arriving at school late can be distressing for children, it also means that an adult is taken away from teaching to settle them into school. Parents and carers with children who repeatedly arrive late will be contacted by Mr. Whitehead to discuss solutions and support that school can offer to improve punctuality.

We operate a 'soft start' to the school day. Gates are opened at 8:45am and the registers are closed at 9am.


We are proud to have been asked to support another local school and feel that this is in keeping with our school values.
