- Set up on the day, help at the fair or tidy up afterwards

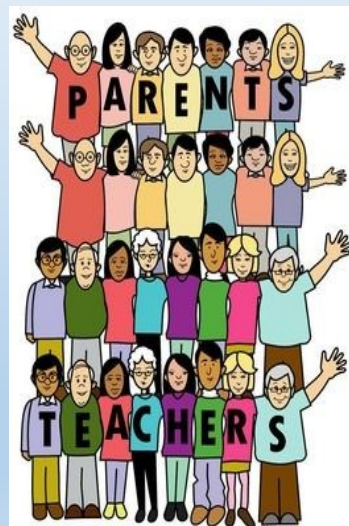
All help is very much appreciated and we can only hold events with your support.
