### September

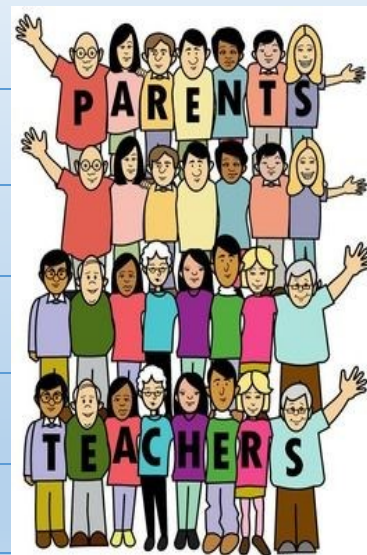

**VIP hospital passport**

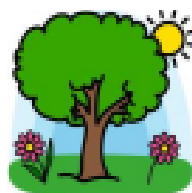
Find out how you can get a VIP hospital passport and how it can help you get the best care for your child.

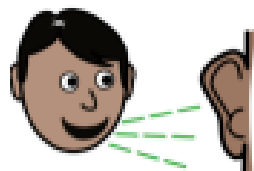

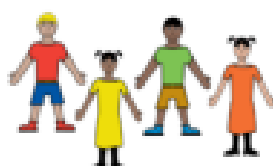
