### Pride

On Friday 23rd June we will be celebrating pride month with the children. They will spend the afternoon in their houses doing related activities.

Children are welcome to come to school wearing their house colour. If children do not know the colour of their house they can ask their Class teacher

In school the children are taught about 'Protected Characteristics'. It is against the law to discriminate against anyone because of:

- age
- being married or in a civil partnership
- being pregnant or on maternity leave
- dísabílíty
- race including colour, nationality, ethnic or national origin
- religion or belief
- sex
- sexual orientation

The aim of teaching children about Pride in school is to be more inclusive, and to give LGBTQ+ children the representation they need to feel safe and supported in society.

We will be learning more about Pride and the history of Pride. The children will choose one of the 20 Pride flags to create and form part of the bunting which will be used at the village Pride event in August.


