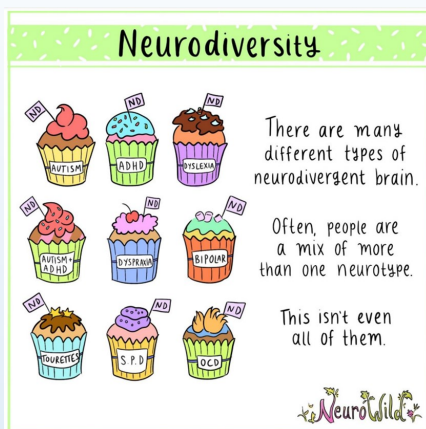


## Easter Lunch

Year two guests - 1.30pm



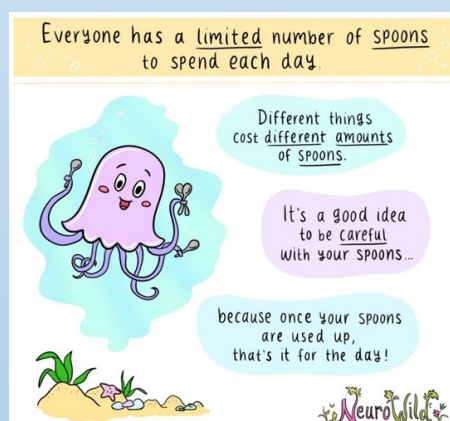
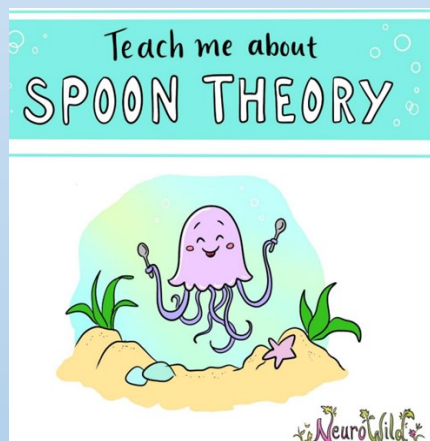


## Neurodiveristy

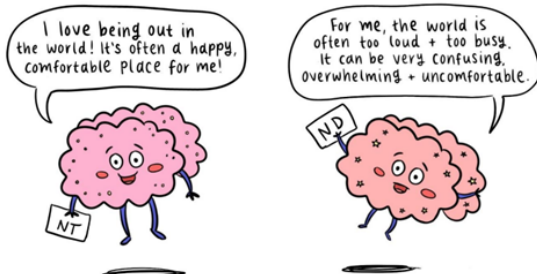

## Why do we label? Why is it important to understand ALL brains?

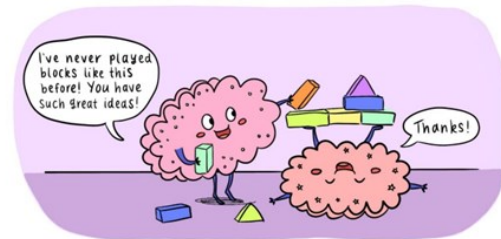
It's important to know what kind of brain we have so we can take care of it properly.

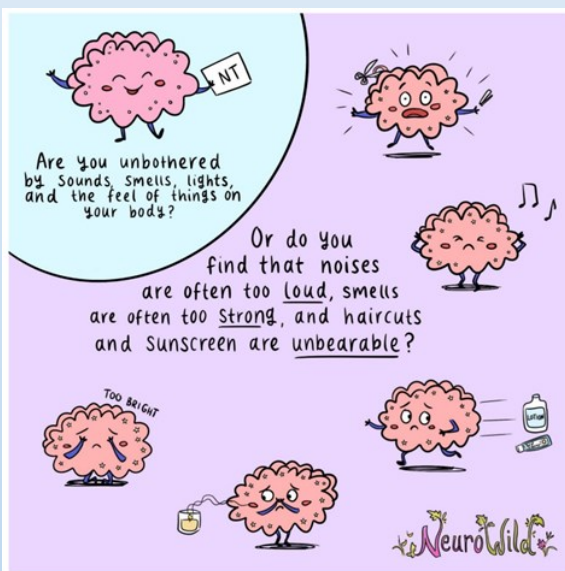
ALL brains are EQUALLY important.

Sometimes people think that neurotypical brains are the best ones, just because they are the brains that lots of people are used to.

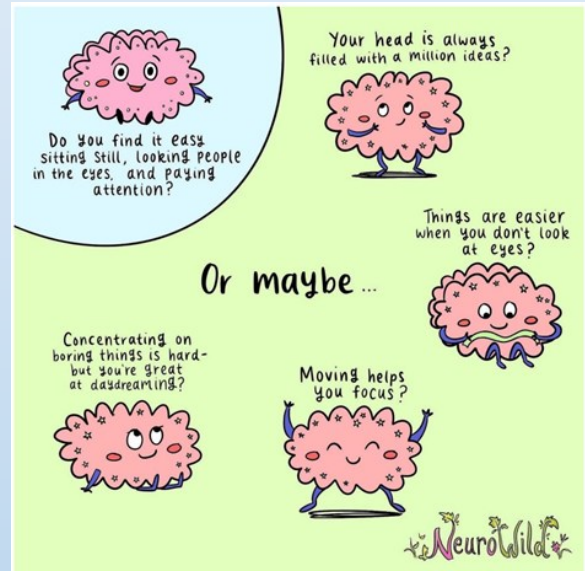

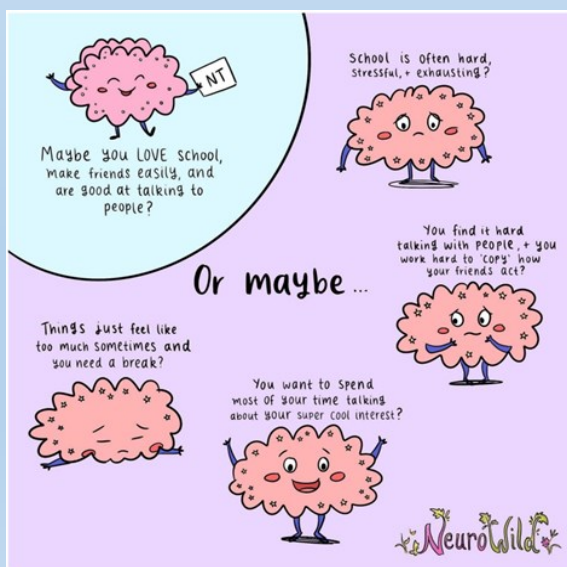
