Free School Meals / Pupil Premium

Did you know that you may be eligible for Free School Meals? If your annual household gross income is below £16, 190 then you can submit a confidential application to the local authority. School does receive funding for every pupil that is in receipt of free school meals and you may have heard this being called Pupil Premium. This is currently £1455 per year. Currently, all Reception, Year One and Year Two children receive a free school meal which is part funded by the government (Universal Free School Meals). For this reason, even if your child is in Reception, Year One or Year Two, it is still worthwhile applying for Free School Meals/Pupil Premium as the school will receive the £1455 allocated per pupil. Furthermore, this funding will remain in place until your child reaches the end of primary school, even if your income rises above the threshold.
