

Safeguarding

Please support us in keeping children safe at home-time by keeping your child with you once they have been handed back. It would be helpful if you did not encourage children to return to school for forgotten items as it can become confusing for staff seeing children out. It is sometimes necessary for staff to hand over information to parents and carers on collection, congregating around doorways makes this difficult for staff and parents/carers to have these conversations.

Some families continue to report that it is difficult to get through the entrance from the church path, please vacate the area outside Robins class as soon as you can. Please share this information with other adults who may collect your child. Thank you for your support to keep children safe.



Transition Mornings

We will be holding two transition mornings where children will be spending time with their class teacher and new pupils in their class. This will take place on Monday 3rd and Tuesday 4th July between 9.15am and 12pm. You will be informed which class your child will be in next year on Friday 16th June. A reminder that this decision is made taking a number of factors into consideration. This is not based solely on children's ability.



Parking

This is just a gentle reminder about parking during drop off and collection. Please do not park against the wall next to the Peggy Wilson Playing Field. This obstructs the view of pedestrians and also the flow of traffic through the village. Please be courteous and respectful to our neighbours and do not park blocking driveways. I would advise against dropping your children by the gates, this is

Winners!




