Should you wish to discuss anything with your child's class teacher, they can be contacted via their email in the usual way.

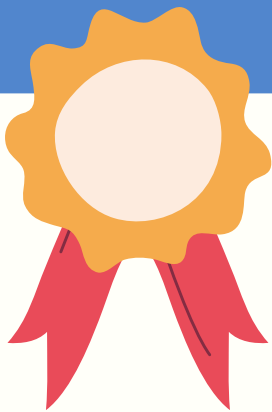

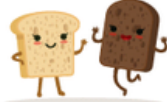
