. Please contact school if you would like to book a place on any of these time slots. Space will be limited to two families per slot. Thank you.


Parent Governor Voting

The nasal influenza vaccination is being offered to all children in Reception-Year 7.



If you would like your child to receive this immunisation, please ensure your consent form has been **submitted no later than 18/10/2020**.


