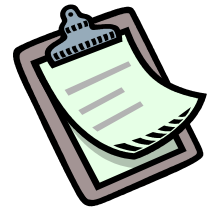

This will take place via Google Hangouts using the usual format. Within this, we will be saying goodbye to our wonderful Year Six children.

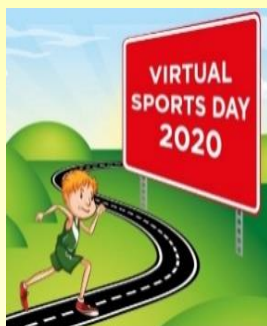
Joining instructions will be sent next week.
