

## Arriving at school

### Robin Class – Change to Start Time

From Monday 21st September, Robin Class drop off time slot will be the earlier time of 8:45am - 9am.

This is because lots of children are needing to start school before 9am and as a consequence their drop off time is lasting half an hour. Please be mindful that both Robin class and Swallows will now have the same drop off time and it is really important that you leave the playground as soon as possible to prevent large groups from forming.

## Google Classroom

Please make sure you are signed up to Google Classroom as soon as possible. Teachers will be using it to set homework, including spellings. Staff will also use it to communicate with parents and carers alongside other methods of communication.



## Friday Achievement Collective Worship





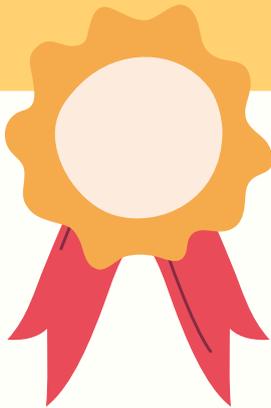
